

By public transportation Nearest train station : (RER) (D) Stade de France-Saint-Denis

From Gare du Nord

Ine direction Orry-la-Ville or Villiers Le Bel. Stop at **Stade de France-Saint-Denis**. From the station way-out walk straight on for 100 meters on **Avenue François Mitterrand**, take second left on **Avenue des Fruitiers**, walk straight on, at the end of the street: building Le Cézanne.

Estimated travel time: 10 minutes.

(B) line direction Charles de Gaulle Aéroport or Mitry Claye stop at La Plaine-Stade de France, take a bus

line **139** or **173** (Bus-stop: Avenue des Fruitiers) or walk from the station way-out (see access map)

In both cases, estimated travel time: 30 minutes

From Gare de Lyon

WD line, direction Orry-la-Ville or Villiers Le Bel. Stop at **Stade de France-Saint-Denis**. From the station way-out walk straight on for 100 meters on **Avenue François Mitterrand**, take second left on **Avenue des Fruitiers**, walk straight on, at the end of the street: building Le Cézanne.

Estimated travel time: 15 minutes.

From Gare St Lazare

Take the Metro (M) **13** (direction Saint-Denis Université). Stop at **Carrefour Pleyel** Metro station. At its way-out, catch the bus line **139**– direction Porte de La Villette – Bus-stop: **Avenue des Fruitiers**.

Estimated travel time: 30 minutes.

From Gare Montparnasse

Take the Metro (M) (direction Porte de Clignancourt) Stop at **Les Halles** Metro station, change for (B) line (direction Orry-la-Ville or Villiers Le Bel. Stop at **Stade de France-Saint-Denis**. From the station way-out walk straight on for 100 meters on **Avenue François Mitterrand**, take second left on **Avenue des Fruitiers**, walk straight on, at the end of the street: building Le Cézanne.

Estimated travel time: 35 minutes.

From Paris – Boulevard périphérique

Exit sign **Porte de la Chapelle** take **Avenue de la Porte de la Chapelle**, turn right direction **Charles de Gaulle**, **Saint-Denis**, **Lille**. Enter into Saint-Denis by **Avenue du Président Wilson**, turn left on **Rue du Landy**, then second right **Rue des Cheminots** which name changes into **Rue Luigi Cherubini** afterwards and finally turn right on **Rue André Campra**.

From A 86

Exit sign N°9 Saint-Denis – La Plaine, Stade de France. Turn right Rue des Trémies direction La Courneuve-Centre, Aubervilliers, Saint-Denis – La Plaine. Enter into Saint-Denis, take Avenue du Stade de France, then turn right Rue Francis de Pressensé. Carry on straight ahead on Avenue François Mitterrand, take first right Avenue des Fruitiers, straight ahead, at its end: Rue André Campra.

From A

Follow Saint- Denis – La Plaine, Stade de France to join A86. Exit sign n N°9 Saint-Denis – La Plaine, Stade de France Turn right Rue des Trémies direction Stade de France Enter into Saint-Denis, take Avenue du Stade de France, turn right Rue Francis de Pressensé.. Carry on straight ahead on Avenue François Mitterrand, take first right on Avenue des Fruitiers, straight ahead, at its end: Rue André Campra.



Parking special instructions

To access to ArcelorMittal's private parking, visitors must go first to the ArcelorMittal Private entrance to be given an entry pass to enter both the private parking and the building (way to the parking follow the _____ on the above map).

The parking is located in Hall 3 and Visitors parking lots are dedicated to ArcelorMittal. To take the lift and return to ArcelorMittal's private entrance ground floor, the entry pass must be presented to the badge reader.

Rules for visitors

Visitors to ArcelorMittal's offices in building Le Cézanne must enter the building through the private ArcelorMittal entrance located at **6 rue André Campra**.

They will be delivered an entry pass to the building in exchange of a proof of identity. This identity document will be given back in exchange of the entry pass upon departure.

They should always be accompanied by their host to access floors and offices
